In 2020, the U.S. Census Bureau will conduct its once-a-decade population count of everyone living in the United States. If you have questions about the census, visit the [2020 Census FAQ webpage](#) or call: 1-800-923-8282.

In mid-March, homes will begin receiving invitations to complete the 2020 Census. Once the invitation arrives, you can respond in one of three ways: online, by phone or by mail. For more information, visit the [2020 Census website](#).

Why your participation matters

Getting an accurate census count is important for schools as it serves as the basis for, among other things, distributing assistance to schools and educational institutions such as:

- National School Lunch program
- Title I aid
- Special education grants
- Head Start program

Census results also determine how many seats the state gets in Congress, influence highway planning and construction, determine grants for public transit systems, secure funding for hospitals and fire departments and much more. The census will never ask you for: your social number, money or donations, your political party affiliation or your bank account or credit card numbers.
