The Golden Acorn

The Golden Acorn Award is a very prestigious Washington State PTA award that is given for exemplary and outstanding volunteerism, dedication, and service to the School Community. Honorees that receive this award, have volunteer experience at the local PTSA level, in the community, and at the school and/or school district level. It is normally given out to a PTSA member who makes a huge difference to Frost kids and is a great way to acknowledge how much their service matters. The recipient is presented with the Golden Acorn Award pin and certificate, their name is added to the Golden Acorn plaque on display in the front office, and a contribution to the Washington State PTA Scholarship Program is made in their name.

Outstanding Educator Award

The Outstanding Educator Award is presented to an individual who has made significant contributions to their community to enhance the educational outcomes of all Frost kids. An educator is not limited to a teacher they may be a teacher, assistant, specialist, support staff, administrator or community member. Recipients receive a pin and certificate, their name is added to the Outstanding Educator Award plaque on display in the front office, and a contribution to the WSPTA Scholarship Program is made in their name.
