After serving the Frost community as Associate Principal for the past four years, Mr. Baileykaze is moving on to a new position for next year as Principal of Sandpoint Elementary School. Mr. Baileykaze joined the Lake Washington School District in 2016, serving at both Robert Frost Elementary and John Muir Elementary as Associate Principal, and this year we were fortunate to have him at Frost full time. His leadership has been critical as we have continued to strengthen instructional programs, equity initiatives, and Roadrunner Pride.
